

# Would I benefit from automatic snow chains?

For the driver safety and timekeeping are crucial. When winter strikes, snowy and icy roads affect both safety and timekeeping. In poor driving conditions, it can be difficult to remain on schedule while being attentive and cautious. Obviously, for you as a driver, this is a cause for stress, and this added stress can lead to unintended consequences.



Snow chains could be a solution to the problem – but only partly. Snow chains increase traction and provide a road grip that mostly is sufficient for safe driving. With snow chains, you don't have to worry about skidding or getting stuck with spinning wheels. However, there is a major flaw: Conventional snow chains must be manually mounted and dismantled. It is a tedious job. First, you have to get out there in the cold and safety clamp the wheels. Then you must mount the heavy chains and rush back to your driver's seat – and try to keep to the schedule. When dismantling the chains, you have to do it all over again.

Apparently, conventional snow chains improve driving safety, but the mounting time affects timekeeping. Not to mention the inconvenience from the heavy and dirty manual work. Once mounted, it is natural to let them stay on even if the road is dry, to save dismantling time and inconvenience. However, this actually decreases safety since braking distance increases with snow chains on dry roads.



The Onspot automatic snow chains may be the optimal traction control for buses and trucks. You get the traction and safety of conventional snow chains – but not the flaws! By pushing a button, the chains are engaged, providing instant traction. Once the road is dry, you just disengage by the button. In this way, you get optimal road grip even if road conditions vary: Tyres on dry road sections and chains on icy sections – just push the button.
